## **Man-made Diamonds**

Tucked away in a couple of small units on a trading estate in Leighton Buzzard, men are making Diamonds. Their raw materials are sheets of plywood, rolls of carpet, lengths of square tube, mats of glassfibre, buckets of resin, tins of paint and bales of cloth. From them they produce some unusual motorcaravans,

based mainly on Volkswagen Transporters with a sprinkling of Mercs and an occasional Mazda. Apart from refrigerators, cookers and sinks, very few complete items are bought in. "We can make exactly what we want," said Alister Whitmore. "It's more efficient than having to adapt our designs to suit components made by outsiders."














